- Lead music classes for groups of 10-20 preschool aged children (ages 1-5)

- Attend monthly meetings with all early childhood faculty to share songs, activities, and best practices
- Follow curriculum guidelines set by the Outreach Coordinator

- Interest in and experience with working with children as young as 1, and as old as 8
- Bachelor's Degree in music, music education/pedagogy, music performance, or an equivalent level of experience and education
- At least 1 year of experience in a related field (preferred)

- Has a strong singing ability (pleasant tone, able to sing in tune without accompaniment)

- Is encouraging, playful, and positive with students and their families
- Must have reliable transportation
